

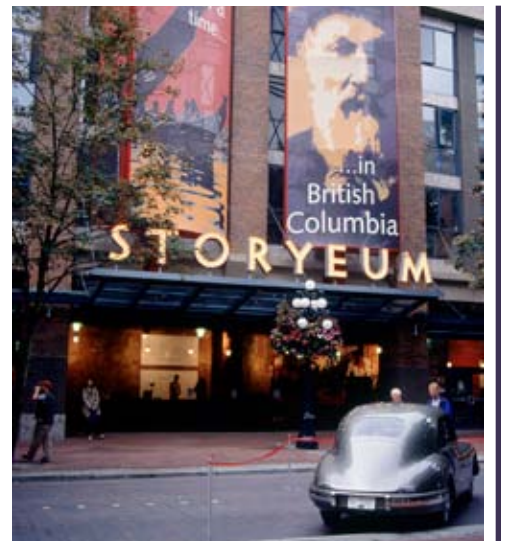

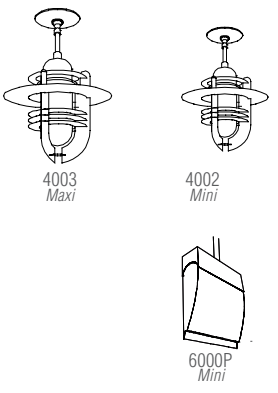
MAXI AND MINI PENDANTS

Rebelle's Saturna family was chosen as the luminaire offering most suited to the project design requirements. The aesthetic, scales, mounting configurations and finishes available for the Saturna family offered the flexibility needed to carry a consistent theme through all areas of the project.

A series of Saturna pendants were used to create a sparkle effect in order to attract attention, define the function of an space and distinguish the larger entrance area.

These pendants created the perception of a dropped ceiling level by introducing a light source at a lower height.

The perimeter walls were illuminated by the Streamline 6000 series pendants. These pendants illuminated the perimeter walls and provided even, asymmetric illumination.
